In 2024, Lara celebrates the centenary of George Gershwin's *Rhapsody in Blue* with a radical new arrangement by the young Puerto Rican composer Edmar Colón, honoring Gershwin's vision of what he called "a musical kaleidoscope of America" with a new orchestration that reflects a century of immigration and transformation, and captures the multicultural sound of America in our own time. This exuberant new take on a beloved American classic launches Lara's multi-year project THIS LAND, a kaleidoscopic collection of new works by composers who represent many different versions of being and becoming American.
